Jeff Lunardi is a principal legislative analyst and project leader for Virginia's Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC), the oversight agency of the Virginia General Assembly. Through analysis, research and evaluation, JLARC helps ensure that the members of the General Assembly are informed about state program operations, agency compliance with legislative intent and efficient and effective program operation. The commission comprises 14 legislative members, the auditor of public accounts as an ex officio member, and employs approximately 30 research staff. Lunardi started at JLARC in 2014 and manages the day-to-day design and execution of JLARC studies. He has led studies of Virginia's Line of Duty Act program, which provides benefits to the families of public safety officers who are killed or permanently disabled in the line of duty, and a comprehensive, two-year study of Virginia's Medicaid program. Previously, Lunardi spent six years with the U.S. Department of Education as a presidential management fellow and then as a program analyst, providing financial oversight for a variety of federal K-12 and higher education programs. He received a Master of Business Administration degree and a bachelor's degree in public policy from the College of William and Mary.
