# **African American Testing Initiative (AATI)**

- **CDC's PA PS07-768**
- “Expanded and Integrated Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Testing for Populations Disproportionately Affected by HIV, Primarily African Americans”

# CDC's PA PS07-768

- Grantee Requirements
  - Initiate new testing programs
  - Maximize proportion who receive results
  - Provide linkages for new positives
  - Provide post-test counseling for new positives
  - Provide linkages for high-risk negatives
  - Link to PCRS for new positives
  - Ensure programs are culturally competent
  - Develop or use existing systems for data collection/QA
  - Report new infections

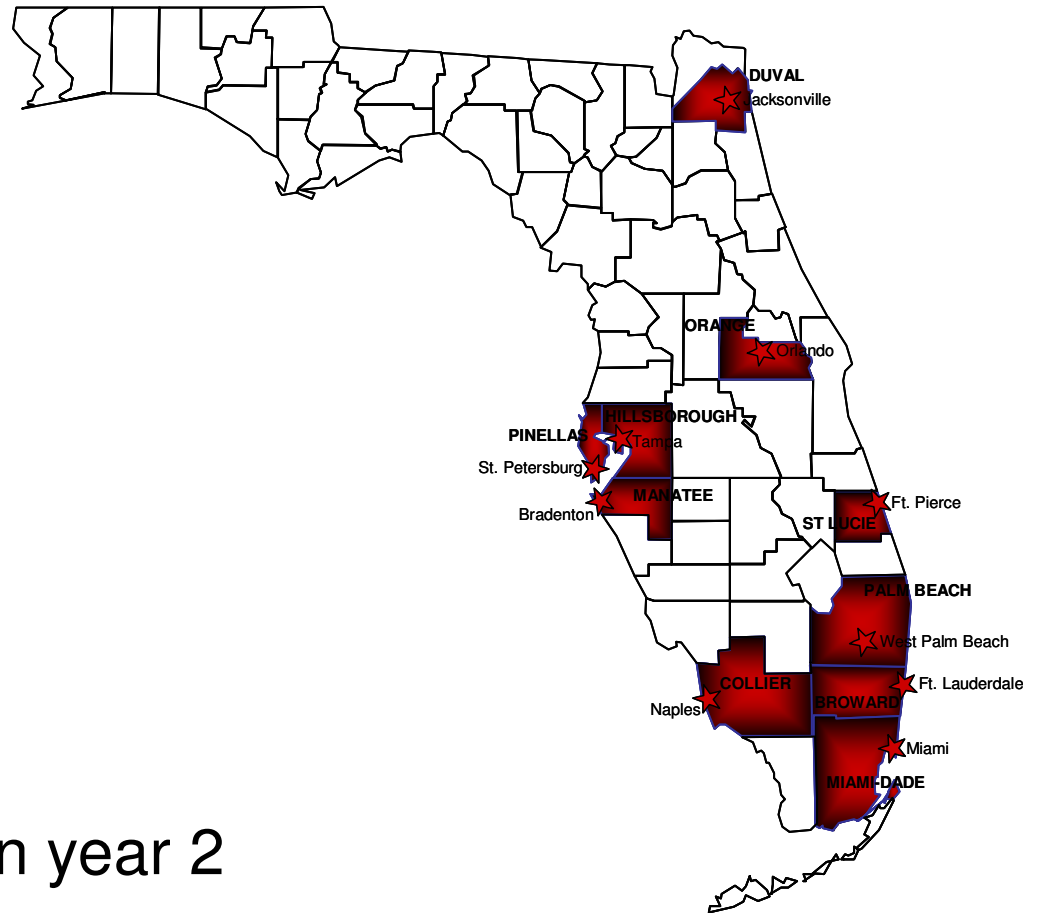
# CDC's PA PS07-768

- Year 1 - Florida
  - Sept. 30, 2007 - Sept. 29, 2008
  - Goal
    - Test: 150,000 individuals
    - Identify: 2,000 new infections
- Year 2 - Florida
  - Sept. 30, 2008 - Sept. 29, 2008
  - Goal
    - Test: 125,000 individuals
    - Identify: 2,000 new infections

Mobile unit	11,832	134 (1.1%)	102 (0.9%)
Drug treatment	7,927	98 (1.2%)	86 (1.1%)

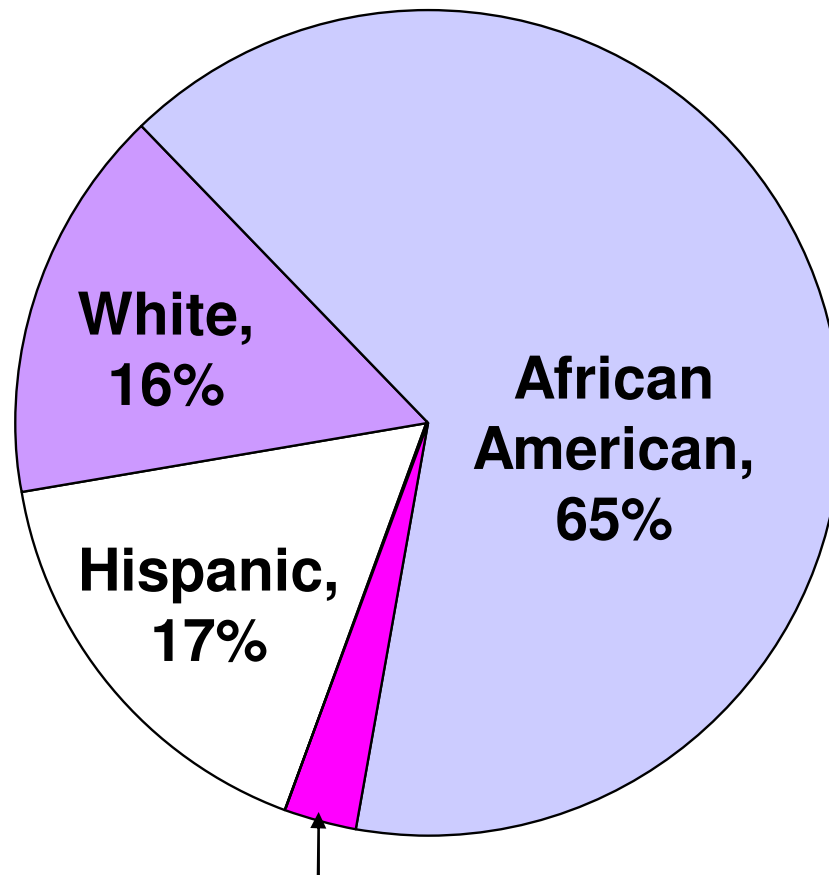

- Total tests in clinical settings: 178,230 (78%)
  - New HIV infections: 1,755 (1.0%)
- Total tests, non-clinical settings: 49,314 (22%)
  - New HIV infections: 626 (1.3%)

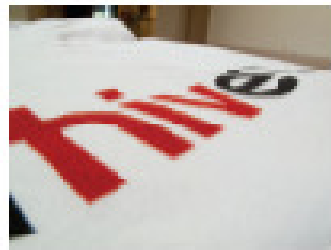
