



CSG SHARED STATE LEGISLATION

The CSG Committee on Shared State Legislation convened on Thursday, Dec. 8 and Saturday, Dec. 10, 2016, to review two dockets. The first docket of the 2018 SSL cycle contained 83 bills on a variety of issues. The second docket, which will be published as a special supplement to the 2018 SSL volume, contained 8 bills on disability employment policy.

For each bill, the committee had four options: include it in the SSL volume; include the bill in the volume as a note, which indicates that the committee believes the bill (and other similar bills addressing the topic) to be of interest to state leaders, but does not merit full inclusion; defer consideration; or reject the bill.

The committee approved 12 bills to be included in the 2018 SSL volume, deferred action on 4 bills to the next meeting of the committee (April 2017), and rejected 60 bills.

The committee also requested that notes be prepared for inclusion in the volume on two topics:

- Coverage for contraceptives
- Enabling the creating of post-secondary programs for the intellectually disabled

The committee members provided CSG staff instructions to include additional legislation and information on several topics for the upcoming CSG meeting in April 2017, including:

- Prescription price increase transparency
- Addressing drone issues
- Efforts to close the wage gap
- Requiring sexual-assault prevention training for college students
- Extending privacy and free speech standards to digital books and electronic reading records

There were 8 bills on the special supplement. The committee approved 2 bills to be included in the special supplement to the 2018 SSL volume, and rejected 6 bills.
