REENTRY 2030: A NEW DECADE OF ACTION TO ENSURE SUCCESSFUL SECOND CHANCES

The CSG Justice Center is igniting a bold national effort to improve outcomes for people who have been incarcerated or involved with the justice system. The effort will focus state leaders and partners to unlock opportunities for people with criminal records. States will set ambitious public reentry goals and commit to work across systems, with a focus on human-centered investments that will result in economic mobility and better outcomes for those exiting prison and on parole or probation.

To launch this effort, the CSG Justice Center will bring together federal and state leaders, private sector partners and others who are on the front lines through a series of virtual convenings that lead up to a national launch event in early 2022 that will set a vision for reentry success.

In late 2022, an unprecedented Reentry 2030 Summit will bring together state and federal officials to solidify state second chance goals while laying the foundation for investment in criminal justice efforts. State teams will be tasked with developing a plan for achieving their Reentry 2030

goals, including removing barriers and addressing gaps in housing, services and training. The result of the meeting will be an ambitious Second Chance Agenda that will serve as a roadmap for significant progress in the states leading up to 2030.

For the 2030 Reentry Summit, the CSG Justice Center will recruit teams from the 50 states (of 6-12 officials each) consisting of corrections administrators and state agencies that are positioned to offer second chances (Departments of Labor, Housing, Health, etc.), state executive branch officials, legislators, reentry leaders and service providers, and groups representing those with first-hand experience in the criminal justice system. Private sector partners, federal agency representatives and White House officials are expected to be among the 500 participants.
