Mission Statement

The Election Technology Initiative is dedicated to maintaining and supporting open-source technologies that ease administrative and financial burdens on election offices, increase access for all voters regardless of location, disability or language, while also improving voter confidence in election results.

The Goal

The Election Technology Initiative is a state-driven program that will maintain and support open-source election software tools that election officials in all states can use to improve security, access and voter confidence while reducing the administrative and financial burden of elections.

The Election Technology Initiative Working Group

The working group will meet quarterly to discuss updates to technologies, future technology solutions, technology pilots or implementations, and review upcoming publications. This group will be made up of 10 election officials:

- 2 nominated by National Association of Secretary of State
- 2 nominated by National Association State Election Directors
- 2 nominated by National Association State Election Officials
- 4 selected by CSG and The Turnout

Advisory Council members will be invited to participate as subject matter experts as needed.

The Election Technology Initiative Advisory Council

The Advisory Council will meet semi-annually and will drive the future of the Initiative including determining what technologies come under the program. The council will be made up of three to five executive and legislative branch members from each CSG region and will include:
